With their enthusiastic help, Loving One by One was able to treat over 2,300 patients in six different medical clinics, and distribute de-worming pills to over 5,000 children. On the first full day the team got right to work in the rural village of Jjokolera where AIDS has eliminated the majority of the middle generation. The remaining adults are elderly grandparents who are raising grandchildren.

Former team members reconnected and new team members quickly bonded. There were lots of laughs and good times while each person worked hard to serve the beautiful people of Uganda. Children are always a highlight for team members as they are eager to meet, hug and hold hands with the team members. The children are quick to smile, and they love the special attention given to them.

Mission team members were very busy learning the ropes during the first clinic but soon got “into the groove” to treat over 350 people in the village of Jjokolera. In addition to the various medicines and de-worming tablets, several reading glasses were given to those in need. Many of the elderly were excited to be able to see or read clearly and were especially happy that they will be able to read their Bibles again. Photo below shows some of those happy faces with their new glasses.

There was a little 4-year-old girl named Naluga with a temperature of 105 degrees Fahrenheit who had to be taken to the nearest hospital.

After praying for little Naluga we put her and her grandmother on the boda boda (motorbike) and sent them off to the hospital. Later we had to take another patient to the hospital – a very sick 17-year-old pregnant girl who needed immediate injections for malaria.

The Village of Jjokolera is ran by an all women council. These women work hard to make their village a better place to live. LOBO has provided goats and pigs to enable the women to raise the animals and sell the offspring to help pay for school fees for their grandchildren. This animal project is always open to new donations to continue helping the people of Jjokolera to help themselves. They know that they have been blessed by God, so they too bless others by giving the first offspring to another village.

WHO WE ARE AND WHERE WE SERVE

Loving One by One Ministry was started in January 2005 by Ken and Sherry Roberts whose passion for the poorest children of Uganda led them to start New Creation Centre, a school offering free education and 2 hot meals a day for refugee children from northern Uganda and Sudan. Their vision was to be able to reach many more refugee children for whom education would be otherwise impossible. In 2007, LOBO established New Creation Family Home, providing a home for orphaned children. Both NCC and NCFH are staffed by qualified, caring Ugandans with NCFH operating in a true family atmosphere. Now that LOBO has acquired the 9 beautiful acres of land, the next immediate goal is to establish a village atmosphere for New Creation Family Homes and School. Here children will learn to grow their own food, care for farm animals, and practice life skills enabling them to contribute to the local community. A future goal is to add a medical clinic offering quality health care for the poorest in the surrounding area.
